Recycling aluminium uses only around **5% of the energy and emissions** needed to make it from the raw material!

Cans are shredded and any coloured coatings are removed before being melted in a furnace.



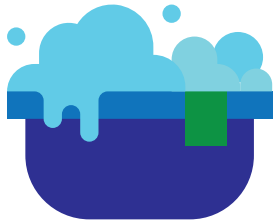
The molten metal is poured into moulds and set into bars called 'ingots'. These are then used to produce more aluminium cans!



Your cans could be recycled, back on sale and heading to your home in as little as **60 days!**



Please ensure your recycling is:



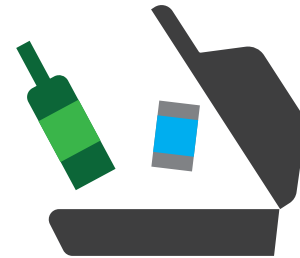
Clean
