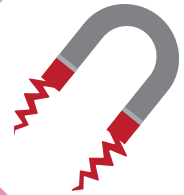
All clean bottle and jar-shaped glass food and drink containers can be recycled.

Please rinse out your jars and bottles - food residue can leak and ruin other recycling.



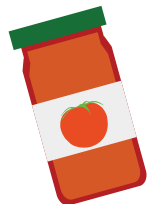
Keep lids on jars and put glass in your recycling bin loose.

At the Materials Recycling Facility glass is crushed and the lids removed via magnet.

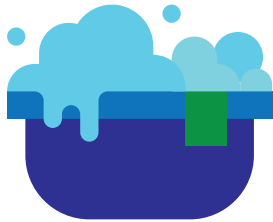


At the reprocessor, crushed glass is melted and moulded or blown into new bottles or jars.

Glass can be recycled over and over again, so your jam jar could come back as a jar for your favourite pasta sauce!



# Please ensure your recycling is:



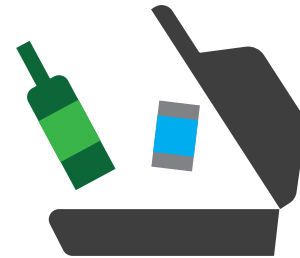
## Clean

## Dry
