

ACTIVITY 3 – MAKE A SOCK SNOWMAN

- You will need:
 - scissors,
 - wide tape,
 - super glue,
 - pins,
 - thread,
 - white terry sock,
 - buttons,
 - scrap fabric and
 - about 1kg of rice.
- Cut off the foot part of the sock just few inches before the heel. The foot part is going to be a hat later on so put this to one side.
- Take the rest of the sock and turn it on the left side before you tightly tie the cut end of the sock with a thread.
- Now turn it back to the right side.
- Take the wide tape ring and pull the cuff of the sock through it. Stretch it over the tape ring to make it more comfortable to pour the rice into it.
- Pour the rice into the sock, you can use the measuring dish instead of a spoon, it'll probably be faster. The more rice you add, the more bumpy your snowman will be. The amount of rice needed will depend on the size of the sock your using.
- Shape Snowman's body and head a bit before you tie it on top and finish shaping its head.
- Tie the top with a thread. Do it firm to avoid the rice from coming out.
- Cut the leftover thread.
- Shape the head by tying a thread around the "neck" few times.
- Now it is time to become a real stylist. Go creative here, and give him the best clothes you can make!
- Make a scrap fabric scarf...
- Fold the foot part of the sock 2 or 3 times to make a cosy hat.
- Pour a little bit of super glue onto the button and carefully stick it to his belly (you may optionally use double sided tape!). Do the same thing with a second button.
- The most important part is the face that means personality ;) Take three pins and make this cute, little face appear!
- Now you are ready with your new, snowy friend... or Snow Sockman as some say ;)
