Cling film is a non-recyclable single-use plastic that causes problems for the environment. UK households get through a whopping 1.2 billion metres of it

per year, so swapping it for a more eco-friendly alternative can make a real difference – and you could save money too. So #swap2save today!

Plate/bowl

No additional cost

To store leftovers in the fridge, simply pop in a bowl and cover with a plate.



Reusable beeswax or vegan wraps

Average cost per item: £5.00

Stainless steel box

Average cost per item: £17.00

Will last for many years, strong, won't discolour and very unlikely to break.



Reusable cotton sandwich/snack bag

Average cost per item: £6.00

The sandwich bag is made with a wipeable, water resistant polyester inner and cotton outer. It's washable so can be used again and again. At the end of its life, the cotton outer can be composted.



Reusable silicon lid/cover

Average cost per item: £1.19

Keeps food fresh and can be used again and again. Microwave, freezer and dishwasher safe.



Reusable plastic tub

Average cost per item: £3.50

Great for storing a wide range of foods for the fridge or freezer as well as in packed lunches.



Bamboo fibre lunchbox

Average cost per item: £7.50

Reusable, easy to clean and made from sustainable bamboo. These lunchboxes are made from natural materials and are biodegradable.
