

What you can recycle at Norfolk's recycling centres

These are some of the items you can recycle. For more information visit www.norfolk.gov.uk/recycling or speak to a member of staff.

- ✓ Batteries (household and car)
- ✓ Business waste - accepted at some sites (see table)
- ✓ Cardboard
- ✓ Cooking oil
- ✓ DIY waste*
- ✓ Electrical goods
- ✓ Empty gas bottles
- ✓ Green waste
- ✓ Light bulbs
- ✓ Mobile phones
- ✓ Scrap metal
- ✓ Textiles
- ✓ Tyres (chargeable)

* A pay as you throw service for DIY waste is available at all of our recycling centres. This type of waste is not household waste and therefore is chargeable. This includes waste created from the construction, demolition, alteration or repair of a home or garden. Materials may include a sink, bath, kitchen unit, radiator, fence panel, guttering, rubble, soil and turf. For more information visit: www.norfolk.gov.uk/diywaste

What you can't take

- ✗ Ammunition or explosives
- ✗ Animal waste - including dead animals and cat and dog faeces
- ✗ Asbestos
- ✗ Clinical waste - medicines, dressings, syringes, needles, soiled products
- ✗ Fireworks and flares
- ✗ Fuel (diesel, petrol or any other type)
- ✗ Hazardous chemicals*
- ✗ Hot ashes or coals
- ✗ Industrial waste
- ✗ Paint *
- ✗ Waste from charities, councils, churches, community groups or schools (see trade waste)
- ✗ Waste not from your own home

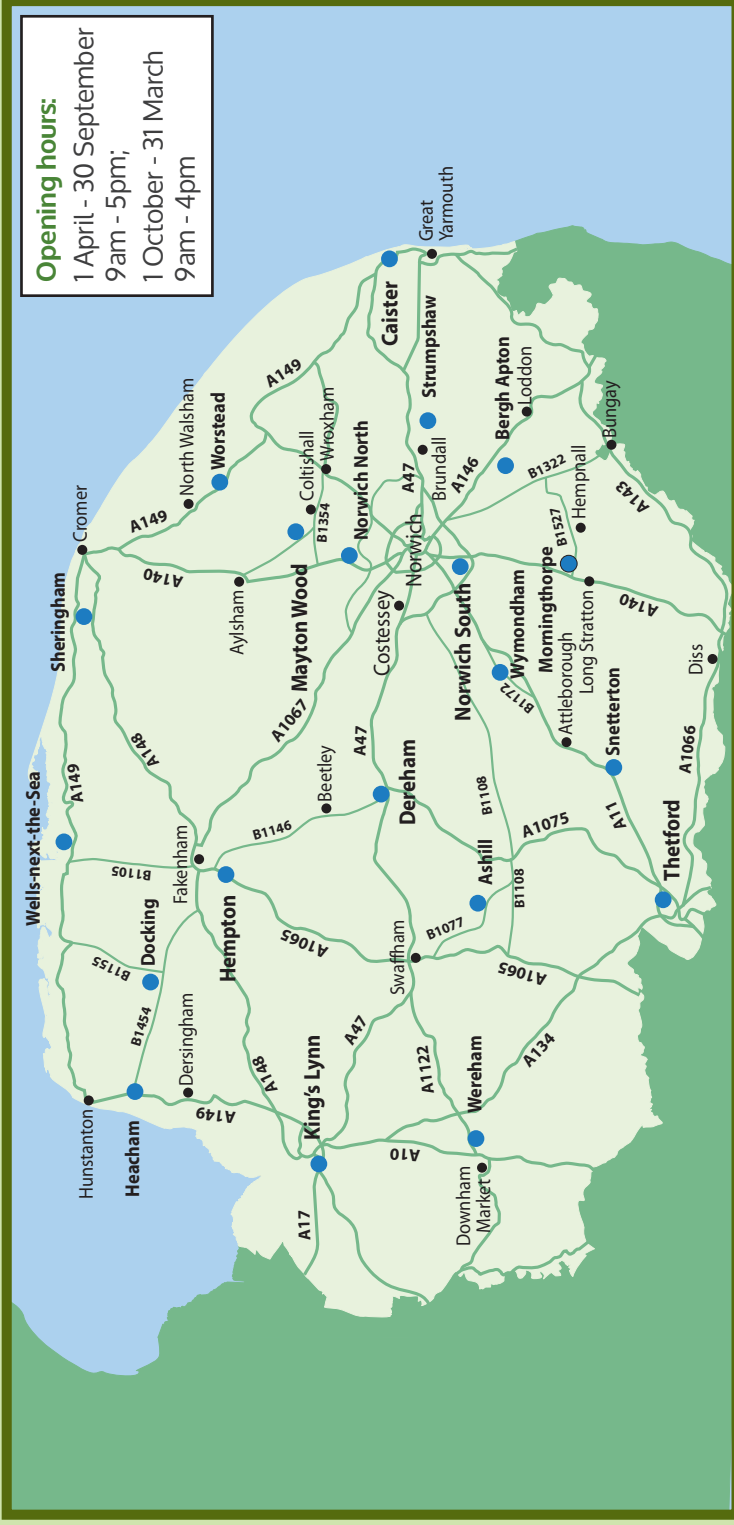
