- 1 Melt the chocolate eggs in the microwave or over a pot of simmering water, leave to cool slightly.
- 2 Add a selection of small/chopped up sweets/chocolates, marshmallows, biscuit pieces, puffed rice, dried fruit, popcorn etc and stir well.
- 3 Spoon into cupcake cases then refrigerate to set.
