### SIMPLER RECYCLING

The introduction of the simpler recycling legislation will mean that your business will have to ensure its waste is separated into three different bins: Dry Recycling, Food Waste and Residual Waste.

### WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR MY BUSINESS?

If you are a business with 10 or more full-time equivalent employees, you will need to ensure your business is compliant with the new simpler recycling legislation by **31st March 2025**.

For those businesses with fewer than 10 full time equivalent employees - you will need to comply to these changes by **31st March 2027**.

# HOW TO RECYCLE RIGHT

RECYCLING	<p>Dry recycling can be collected all together in one bin.</p> <p>This includes items such as:</p>	 Paper and cardboard	 Plastic bottles	 Plastic pots, tubs and trays
		 Cartons	 Glass bottles and jars	 Food and drink cans
FOOD WASTE	<p>Food waste will require a separate collection</p> <p>This includes:</p>	 Tea bags	 Coffee grounds	 Meat and Bones
		 Fruit and veg peelings	 Leftovers	 Dairy
GENERAL WASTE	<p>General waste will require a separate collection for:</p>	 Coffee cups	 Polystyrene containers	 Crisp packets
		 Paper towels	 Sweet wrappers	 Single use cutlery
